First round starts promptly at 9:00 am. All players should be on site and checked in by 8:45 am. You must be pre-registered or you will not play in the first round. Players will be paired Friday night by the tournament director.

Entry Fees

- \$20 if pre-registered by Friday Feb. 24th at 7 PM. Pre-register at www.spacecoastchess.org
List of pre-registered players will be posted on our web site. Please email any changes/corrections to scott@spacecoastchess.org.
- \$25 for on-site registration. On-site registration will receive a 1/2 point bye for round 1.
- First Time Players are Free- If this is your very first USCF tournament ever you don't have to pay the \$20. However, you must pre-register and you need to purchase a USCF membership.
- USCF membership required- This can be purchased at the tournament on Saturday for \$14 (yearly membership) through Brevard Chess Center (see Chris Bortzner) or in advance from USCF- <https://secure.uschess.org/webstore/member.php>
- Tournament fees will be collected at the tournament site (you cannot pay online)
- Cash or Check. Make checks payable to Space Coast Scholastic Chess

Trophies-Top 10 individuals each section, top 3 teams (K-3, K-5 & K-8) (team score from top 4 boards, minimum of 2). Top team trophy for K-1 and K-12. Biggest upset for each section and medals awarded for all first time players.

Top 3 teams & top 3 individuals from each section will be invited to the Florida All-Star Tournament (in April, date and location tbd)
